

# INOUI INUIT !

Size adaptable  
2 skeins of Cascade Magnum  
A little waste yarn  
Aiguilles n° 12 mm  
2 circular needles whatever size  
A tapestry needle

## Garter sts

Shorts rows (SR) : K 18 sts, WP.

## Wrap and Turn (WP):

Row 1 : on the right side knit to turning point. Slip next stitch purlwise to right needle. Bring the yarn to the front between the needles. Return the slipped stitch to the left needle. Bring the yarn to the back between the needles. Turn work (wise side) and continue to the end.

Row 2 : Knit to the turning point. You will see a horizontal bar of yarn lying in front of the stitch that you slipped before you turned the work. This is the wrap. Insert tip of right needle into both the wrap and the wrapped stitch and knit them together (this pushes the wrap to the back of the work and closes the gap).

Gauge : 4 x 4 inches = 8 sts x 14 rws



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With the waste yarn, provisional cast on 36 sts, then K with the Cascade Magnum.  
Short rows every 6 th rows. You will have 3 garter's ribs between every SR.

When you have enough length (on the larger side of the work, the shorter is the neck side) to stretch (a little) around your shoulders , put the last row on a circular needle, bring the waste yarn over and put the first row's sts on the other circular needle.(it's easier for the grafting)  
Graft this 2 rows with a tapestry needle.
